

Troop 74 Disciplinary Report Form

Members of Troop 74 are to live by the Scout Oath and Scout Law throughout their daily lives and in all scouting experiences. The intent of this form is to document behavior contrary to the Scout Oath or Scout Law. Adults who observe behavior and/or actions deemed inappropriate and contrary to the principles incorporated in the Scout Oath and Scout Law should complete this form and submit it to the Troop 74 Scoutmaster for disposition.

Disposition of behavior contrary to the Scout Oath and/or Scout Law: (Discipline Levels 2-5 require documentation.)

- Level 2 situation - Verbal warning and conference with the Scout:** Adult Leader(s) and/or Scoutmaster will speak to the Scout with the intent of correcting the behavior and to discuss and/or impose consequences.
- Level 3 situation - Verbal warning and parental notification:** Scoutmaster and Adult Leader(s) will speak to the Scout regarding the inappropriate behavior and the Scout's parent(s)/guardian(s) will be notified. The parent(s)/guardian(s) will be advised of the repeated inappropriate behavior and imposition of consequences will occur.
- Level 4 situation - Conference with at least two adult leaders, including the Scoutmaster, to discuss the Scout's removal from a meeting, event, outing, etc.** If a majority agrees, an adult leader will contact the parent(s)/guardian(s), explain the behavior, and advise the parent(s)/guardian(s) to immediately come to remove the Scout from the meeting, event, outing, etc. A follow-up meeting will be held with the Scoutmaster, at least two adult leaders, the Scout, and the parent(s)/guardian(s) to discuss the problem, consequences, and options for improving future behavior within two weeks or as soon as can be arranged.
- Level 5 situation - Expulsion and revocation of membership in Troop 74**—as per guidelines outlined in Discipline Policy.

Consequences may include, but not limited to:

- Extra responsibilities** (i.e. extra kitchen duty, fetching water or firewood, cleaning outhouse, etc.)
- Parental accompaniment on Scout activity**
- Removal from Scout activity**
- Loss of privilege(s) at meeting or event** (Specify privilege denial: _____)
- Suspension from Troop Meetings, Activities, and/or Outings for a period of time** (Specify time period of suspension: beginning date _____ ending date _____)
- Loss of time accumulated for Rank Advancement**
- Expulsion from the Troop**
